

WORLDTHREADING: Multimedia poetry workshop

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS: 1 April 2023

IMMART is accepting applications from IMMART Network artists who work with literature, poetry and/or performance for ARTIVAL RE:CONNECT. Six artists will be selected to participate in a tailored workshop on multimedia poetry and performance led by Elizabeth Torres from Red Door.

ABOUT THE CALL

The half-day workshop will take place at the festival hub URBAN13 which lies in a unique on the border of three districts of Copenhagen: Frederiksberg (a wealthy municipality within the borders of Greater Copenhagen), Nord Vest (a former working class district that is highly populated and an emerging vibe for creative people and organisations) and Nørrebro (the "coolest" most ethnically diverse district in Copenhagen).

Six local artists from the IMMART Network will be selected to participate in the workshop together with two Iceland-based artists. The workshop, led by <u>Elizabeth Torres</u> and <u>Pablo Saborío</u> from Copenhagen-based <u>Red Door</u>, will be tailored to address the participating artists' needs. In the evening, there will be multilingual poetry readings/performance at a different location (to be determined) featuring the Icelandic Artists, Elizabeth and Pablo followed by an open mic for those who wish to make a reading.

- This is a multidisciplinary project and is open to all traditional and non-traditional poets and spoken word artists who are members of the IMMART Network and **living in Denmark**. It is free to join the network on Facebook here: <u>IMMART Network | Facebook</u>
- Artists at all stages in their art career are invited to submit examples of their work in the format of their choice.
- Artists should keep in mind the need for a consistent and strong body of work when submitting their application.
- Upon submission of receipts, IMMART will reimburse up to 200 DKK for transport and 300 DKK food & drinks for each selected artist.

ARTIVAL RE:CONNECT is a multilingual cultural festival taking place across the Nordic region in 2023 between March and June 2023. It brings artists, cultural workers and organizations together in a sustainable manner to co-create and reflect on issues of inclusion and belonging through art, exhibitions, performances, talks, workshops and recitals.

We are living in fractured times, in which people feel increasingly disconnected, not only from those immediately around them – friends, family and neighbours - but also from their fellow citizens, especially those they deem different to themselves.

Inspired by Noreena' Hertz's bestselling book *The Lonely Century: A Call to Reconnect*, **ARTIVAL RE:CONNECT** is a unique cultural festival taking place across the Nordic region this spring and summer that deploys poetry, music, theatre, visual art, performance and dance, with the dual goal of shedding light on these important themes and playing a part in the solution.

By using art to expose attendees to difference - different people, different approaches, different perspectives - and by providing them with new ways to connect and reconnect (with themselves, their local community and the wider world) **ARTIVAL RE:CONNECT** will not only inspire, it will actively help its audiences to come together, co-create and unite.
